## Prime Minister's Trip to England Next April



### Deadlines Are Approaching

It's not too late to sign up for Prime Minister Marilyn's trip to England, Scotland and Wales, but time is running out.

Deadline is Nov. 10 for deposits of \$480 per person. Final payment will be due

Feb. 13, 2015. The total price of \$3,999 includes insurance, air fare, hotel, bus transportation, most meals, admission to castles, palaces, theater performances and much, much more. An optional event, called "A Scottish Night Out," is available for an additional \$100.

The group will spend four days in London, stay one night in an ancient castle in Wales, travel through the beautiful English Lake District, tour Edinburgh and Scotland's Border area, walk in the city of York, and spend the last two nights in Stratford Upon Avon.

Rosarians will depart Portland on Tuesday, Apr. 14, and return Saturday, Apr. 25. The travel company, Collette Vacations, contracts with several airlines, and at this time the carrier for this trip has not been chosen.
