together! Please join us at 7:00 p.m. on Tuesday, July 29, at my home, 2423 Remington Drive, West Linn, to meet others, talk about the trip, and get answers to any questions you may have. Ben Stanford from Collette Vacations will be here. We are now less than ten months from departure to England, Scotland and Wales. We'll spend four nights in London, one night in a castle in Wales, two nights in Edinburgh, one night in York and two nights in Stratford.

At least 44 people have paid their deposit, so the first bus is full. We are hoping to fill a second bus, which will require 26 additional passengers. Oregon lost its 32nd governor Sunday night when Victor G. "Vic" Atiyeh succumbed to renal failure at a Portland hospital. Atiyeh was 91 in February, and served two terms as Oregon governor, from 1979 to 1987. He was in failing health after a fall he endured earlier this month. His family, including his wife of 70 years, Dolores, son Tom, daughter Suzanne, and brother, Edward were by his side at



the time of his passing. He is the brother of deceased Duke of the Realm Richard Atiyeh and uncle to Sir Knight Tom Marantette and Lady Mary Winn, and Sir Knight Bruce Mitchell and Lady Catherine. Our sincere condolences to the entire family. Vic's life will be memorialized in a public service sometime in September.
